



Emily serves as the Executive Director of the Connecticut RISE Network. The RISE Network's mission is to ensure all RISE school students graduate with a plan and the skills and confidence to achieve college and career success.

Emily co-founded RISE in 2015 and has grown the organization to include over 30 staff and nine core partner high schools across eight districts; together, RISE staff and partners have improved Grade 9 on-track, graduation, and college access and readiness rates.

In 2020, RISE was one of two organizations nationally to be recognized with the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching's Spotlight on Quality in Continuous Improvement.

Prior to leading RISE, Emily served as Engagement Director at Mass Insight Education, leading consulting engagements with school districts and state education agencies around the country.

Previously, Emily supported data and college and career readiness efforts at New Visions for Public Schools.
